

MINUTES OF CANVASSING BOARD
HELD OCTOBER 13, 2014

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the Canvassing Board met at the City Office on Monday, October 13, 2014 at 2:00 P.M. with the following members present: Commissioner Dale Robbins, President Richard Johnson, City Attorney and City Auditor. Commissioner Craig Stromme joined the meeting via telephone.

President Johnson called the meeting to order and stated the purpose of the meeting was to canvass the votes from the special city election held October 7, 2014.

Three absentee ballots were received after the election. The ballots were postmarked after the due date of October 6, 2014.

Commissioner Robbins moved to declare the ballots postmarked after October 6, 2014 void and to not open or count the ballots as part of the special city election. The motion was seconded by the City Attorney, and the motion carried unanimously.

The election results were reviewed. There were 872 no votes and 705 yes votes.

Commissioner Stromme moved to approve the election results of 872 no votes and 705 yes votes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Robbins, and the motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, President Johnson adjourned the meeting at 2:14 P.M.
