What is the Project?

The City of Devils Lake, in cooperation with the North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing improvements along 8th Ave SE, 10th Ave SE, 16th St SE, & 17th St SE in Devils Lake, North Dakota.

A National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) document will be developed, which will analyze the potential social, economic, environmental, and other impacts of the project, including any floodplain and/or wetland impacts of the proposed improvements at the structure site.



Where is the project located?

The project is in Devils Lake, North Dakota along 8th Avenue Southeast SE from 11th Street SE to 17th Street SE; 10th Avenue SE from 15th Street SE to 17th Street SE; 16th Street SE from 10th Avenue SE to 17th Street SE; and 17th Street SE from 8th Avenue SE to the U.S Highway 2 junction. What is the purpose of the project?


The proposed project would consist of roadway reconstruction, including subgrade repair; hot mix asphalt surfacing; and curb and gutter.



What alternatives are being studied?

The following alternatives will be moving forward for further analysis.

- Alternative A: No-Build: The existing roadway and infrastructure would remain as-is, with the continuation of current maintenance practices. The existing roadway would continue deteriorating and potentially lead to unsafe driving conditions. Alternative A would not meet the project's purpose and need.
- Alternative B: Build: The existing roadways would be reconstructed to a rural section or an urban section with curb and gutter. Work on the urban sections would include subgrade repair, hot mix asphalt, and curb and gutter. Work on the rural sections would include subgrade repair and hot mix asphalt.



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Project Funding

The project is estimated at \$3.5 to \$4.0 million and is being funded by the City of Devils Lake and FHWA. Federal Funds are capped at \$1.623 million.

What can you expect during construction?

Construction is anticipated to be completed during the 2024 construction season. The roadways would be closed during construction. Access to houses will be maintained when possible. There will be times when access to driveways will be restricted. Construction areas will be restricted and sequenced so not all corridors are closed at one time. The contractor would furnish and install necessary construction signing and barricades to provide a safe work zone for workers and the travelling public.



What is the purpose of the Public Input Meeting?

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to initiate early communication with the public, inform the public of the project and provide an opportunity to provide feedback regarding the project.
