Tree vouchers will be handed out again this year and they will be increased to \$100 per home owner.

Three members' terms are expiring in June. Paula indicated she would be willing to serve another term. Kevin said he would check with other members of the Planning Commission to see if someone would be interested in serving as a Shade Tree member. Deb's term is also up.

The annual Arbor Day Program will be May 10, 1:00 pm, at Bridgestone Park; Tammy will talk to Minnie H kids for special music; Mark and Eva Olson will donate the tree; Helen will do the

invitations, Arbor Day proclamation, programs and advertisement; Helen will talk to Mike about being guest speaker.

Jack stated he would like to check into increasing the temporary Shade Tree staff salaries by 10%.

The next meeting will be the first Thursday in June at noon.

Cathy made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion 2^{nd} by Tammy. Carried.
