




## SERVICE LINE REPAIR HOMEOWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY

### DID YOU KNOW?

All service lines, curb stops, and other appurtenances from the City's water main to the water meter inside a home are owned by the property owner and are to be maintained in good repair at the property owner's expense. All plumbing and fixtures beyond the water meter are also owned and maintained by the property owner. The one exception is that the City maintains ownership of all water meters inside a property and bears the expense of their operation, maintenance, and replacement - unless the meter is tampered with, becomes frozen, or is otherwise damaged due to fault of homeowner.
